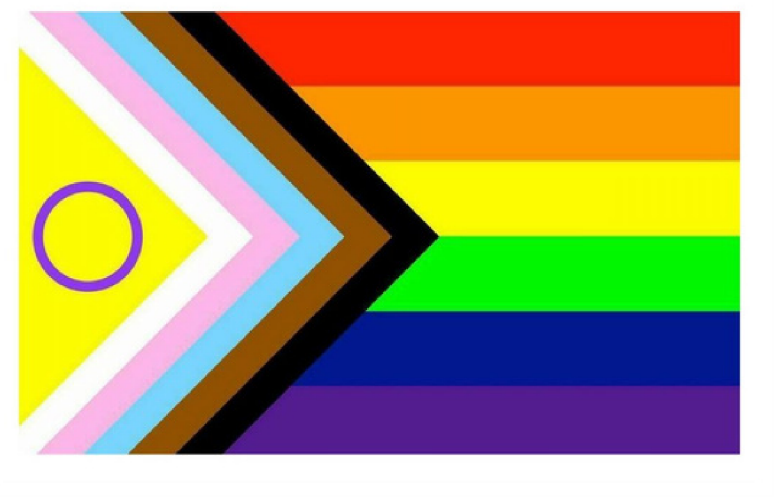
Course Summary
